Program Application Requirement

The Master of Science in Athletic Training (MSAT) Program requires at least 100 total hours of observation under the direct supervision of a Certified Athletic Trainer in two or more settings (e.g., university/college, high school, and/or clinics) within two years of the application date. Students can choose to do their hours at any athletic training site, but all hours must be supervised by a certified athletic trainer (ATC credential holder). If students need assistance finding a site to complete their hours, we have included a contact list for observation sites affiliated with the SDSU MSAT program below. It is the student's responsibility to contact the site and arrange for observation hours. Please contact atpinfo@sdsu.edu for questions about the application process.
