The Master of Science in Athletic Training (MSAT) Program requires at least 100 total hours of observation under the direct supervision of a Certified Athletic Trainer in two or more settings (e.g. university/college, high school, and/or clinic) within two years of the application date. Included in this packet is a <u>contact list</u> for observation sites affiliated withthe SDSU MSAT. It is the student's responsibility to contact the site and arrange for the observation hours. We also ask that you utilize the following forms to document your observation experiences:

- A separate <u>hour log</u> for each clinical setting to document and verity the time and observation experience under the supervision of a Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC).
- A separate <u>student evaluation form</u> for each clinical setting to be completed by the supervising ATCs.
- When applying to the MSAT, please submit the hour logs and evaluation forms as evidence of your minimum 100 hours of observation via the supplemental application using ATCAS.
