We employ graduate students as either Teaching Associates (TAs) or Graduate Assistants (GAs). Assignments for the TA include teaching physical activity classes or teaching undergraduate lab classes. Assignments for the GA position include laboratory prep, running scantrons/grading, graduate and undergraduate advising, research project assistance, facilitating in large lectures.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible for a graduate assistantship, a student must have classified graduate standing (or be close to it) and be actively pursuing a Master's degree in <u>Kinesiology, Exercise Physiology,</u> <u>Nutritional Sciences or Exercise Physiology and Nutritional Sciences</u>. Student with classified standing (versus conditional) have higher priority in the award of a GA/TA position. A conditionally classified student can hold a TA or GA for only one semester.

STIPEND:

GA/TA positions are one-semester appointments and are renewable to maximum of four semesters. The stipend depends on assignment and experience.

APPLICATION:

To be considered for a GA/TA position, a student must upload the following via Interfolio:

(1) A personal cover letter describing relevant experiences and certifications

- (2) Application for Teaching or Graduate Assistantship
- (3) Resume

The deadline for first consideration for the fall semester is **January 12**, with rolling applications accepted thereafter.
